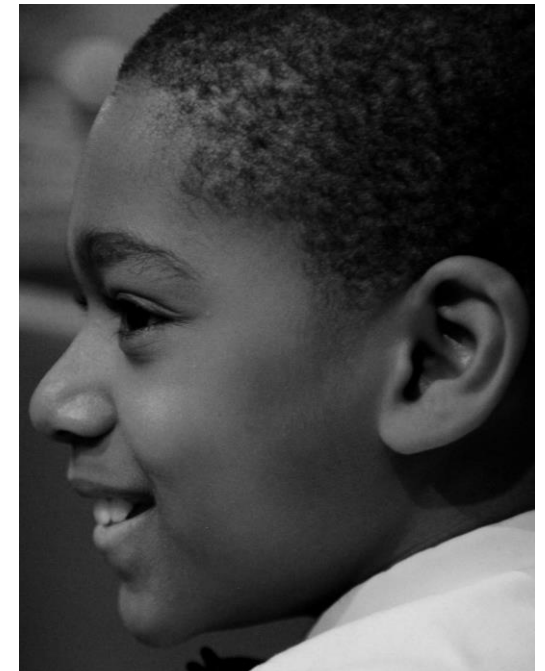

The Mason Chandler Allen Memorial Foundation (MCAMF) was established as a public charity in honor of its 13-year old namesake who succumbed to Osteosarcoma -- the most common bone cancer among children and adolescents -- after a courageous 18-month battle.

Mason was a great friend, gifted student, school ambassador, student leader, musician, football player and ardent Eagles fan. Most importantly, he was a thoughtful, generous and compassionate individual. He sought out the child who was sad, lonely discouraged or hungry and would give them anything he had to make them feel better. It is this legacy the foundation was created to carry on.
